We find hope that God will lead us in victory through our trials. Thus, we continually praise and worship Him regardless of circumstances.

May 29                     Lesson 12 / Revelation 21  
*New Order of Things*

Joy and happiness will be in our hearts, because God will have wiped away every tear and banished every sorrow and pain.

June 5                      Lesson 13 / Revelation 22  
*Water of Life*

At last, we'll be able to see God. Our souls will be at rest when we finally have returned home to God.

### *The Gospel of Mark*

According to the Gospel of Mark, Jesus began His public ministry in the towns and villages of Galilee by proclaiming that the kingdom of God was at hand. Two elements in His ministry – teaching and healing – were so closely linked together that neither one can be understood apart from the other. The purpose of the preaching, or teaching, mission was to make people aware of their need for repentance and to give them a clearer understanding of the way they should live.
